Description

This programme is designed for the individual who would like to become a draughts person, but has limited experience or no experience in technical draughting. The course provides a foundation for students to progress into the multi-disciplinary drawing office practice course.

Admission requirements

A knowledge, comprehension and application of language and mathematics and physical science, on a matric level or equivalent.

Selection Procedure

A candidate with the above qualifications will enter into a selection process that consists of a PIB test (Potential Index Battery test) and screening of grade 12 results.
